

RECYCLING IN THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT HOREB

The following are glass, aluminum, cans, and plastic materials accepted as commingled recyclables:

Aluminum food and beverage containers

Empty aerosol cans

Glass food and beverage containers – brown, clear, or green

Ferrous (iron) cans

PET plastic containers with the symbol #1 – narrow neck containers only

HDPE plastic containers with the symbol #2 – narrow neck containers only (milk containers, water bottles, detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles, etc) without caps

Plastics with symbols #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 – narrow and screw top containers

The following materials are not accepted as recyclable materials:

Lead acid batteries

Dry cell batteries

Microwave trays

Mirrors

Window or auto glass

Light bulbs

Ceramics

Porcelain

Unnumbered plastics

Plastic bags

Coat hangers

Glass cookware/bakeware

Items such as cooking pots, toasters, etc.

Glass containers must be empty and free of food debris, metal caps, and rings.

Tin cans, bi-metal cans, and aluminum cans must be empty and free of food debris.

Plastic containers must be empty and free of food debris and caps.

Mixed residential paper consists of a mixture of various qualities of paper not limited as to type of fiber content. Mixed residential paper recyclables must be dry and free of food debris or other contaminating material and commingled with other recyclables in an orderly fashion or placed in a paper bag. Please do not place mixed residential paper recyclables out for collection in wet or windy weather conditions.

Acceptable mixed residential paper and fibers are as follows:

Newsprint

Corrugated cardboard

Magazines/catalogs

Cereal boxes

Telephone books

Printer/copier paper

Mail

All other office paper without wax liners

Not acceptable: used tissues, paper towels, or paper that has been in contact with food.

ALL RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING BINS AND GARBAGE CONTAINERS MUST BE CURBSIDE BY 7:00AM FRIDAY MORNING. GARBAGE CONTAINERS OR BAGS CANNOT EXCEED 50 LBS in WEIGHT OR 30 GALLONS IN SIZE. NO ITEMS OR MATERIALS SHALL BE PLACED AT CURBSIDE FOR PICKUP MORE THAN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO 7:00AM FRIDAY MORNING. EMPTIED GARBAGE CONTAINERS AND RECYCLING BINS MUST BE REMOVED FROM CURBSIDE NO LATER THAN 12 HOURS AFTER PICKUP.
