

Single-Stream Recycling Service

This means you can put all your recyclables together, no sorting needed! Use your green cart with the yellow lid to place all your standard recyclables together. Place your carts at the curb no earlier than sundown on the day before collection or no later than 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, the day of collection.

Collapse boxes/cut large boxes down to 3'x3'.



Plastic Bottles, Caps and Containers #1-#7
Return plastic bags to retail store collections.




Aluminum Foil & Cans

Rigid Plastics

Like milk crates, laundry baskets, & plastic toys without metal



Trash Service

Trash service will change on a weekly schedule to Wednesdays. Use the green cart with the green lid only for trash that cannot be recycled. Place your carts at the curb no earlier than sundown on the day before collection or no later than 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, the day of collection.

- Candy wrappers
- Carbon paper
- Carpet and cloth
- Food-soiled cardboard

- Food or any organic waste
- Liquids
- Plastic bags and clear plastic wrap
- Plates and dishes
- Dry empty paint cans

- Polystyrene foam containers
- Used paper cups and paper plates
- Used paper towels and tissues
- Waxed cardboard and paper

Cart Placement

Containers need to be at least 2 feet away from each other and any fixed objects. All carts should go to the curb for collection with the handles facing the house. If you are having problems with slopes or the wind, simply rotate the cart a quarter-turn, placing the handle toward the wind. This helps keep the lid closed and the cart upright.

Bulk Items

Residents can call Waste Management at 1 888 960 0008 or email wmeservice@wm.com to schedule payment and pickup of items.

Bulk Waste

- Smaller than 7 feet, lighter than 75 pounds
- Couches, chairs, household furniture
- Carpeting (cut into 4-foot bundles)

NOT Bulk Waste

- Larger than 7 feet, heavier than 75 pounds
- Concrete, brick, asphalt, roofing
- Large appliances, electronics, and white goods
- Large auto parts (engine blocks, fenders, tires, etc)
- Branches, tree trimming, leaves, grass clippings

Hazardous Items

Waste Management will not collect solid or liquid hazardous waste. Examples include paint; pesticides; petroleum derivatives, such as motor oil and solvents; and explosive items.
