

**VILLAGE OF MOUNT HOREB
PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MINUTES**

Monday, April 25, 2022

The Public Works Committee was called to order on the above date at 6:00 pm in the Board Room of the Municipal Building, 138 E. Main Street, Mount Horeb, WI. Members present were Ryan Czyzewski, Jason Fendrick, Tim White, and Rob VanDomelen. Also present were Village Administrator Nic Owen, Public Services Director Jeff Gorman and Office Coordinator Niki Erickson.

Consider February 28, 2022 Minutes: Motion by Fendrick, seconded by White to approve February 28, 2022 minutes. Motion carried.

Consider compost site sign and cost: Gorman presented two different sign options made by Sign Art. Cost of sign is \$906. Village employees would install the sign. There is money in the operating budget for the sign. Board recommends the white backgrounded sign, with red font instead of black for the materials verbiage. Motion by VanDomelen, seconded by White to approve the signs with the adjustments made. Motion carried.

Discuss compost site policies and enforcement: Gorman presented the board with the ordinances of brush and yard waste. The possibility of putting video surveillance at the compost site was discussed. At this time, all ordinances and policies are appropriate. Nothing to change at this time.

Update on 2022 street reconstruction projects: Gorman reviewed project. S & L Underground came in as the lowest bidder for both the Golf View, Lincoln and Garfield St. project, and the Johns St., Alan Dr. project. S & L Underground bid will now go to the Village Board for approval. Deadline for the project got pushed back to November 15, 2022.

Consider recommendation by the Public Safety Committee to add all-way stop at the intersection of Tyrol Terrace and Lillehammer Lane: Gorman gave copies of Encore's development to the board, showing the intersection on Lillehammer Lane and Tyrol Terrace. The Public Safety Committee is recommending an all way stop at that intersection, for two main reasons. Speeding, and that it's a busy area with people getting onto Hwy 18/151 over there. There's also a blind curve on the left coming off of Lillehammer. Encore would be responsible to put the stop sign up since it's a private street. Motion by Fendrick, seconded by VanDomelen for recommendation to add an all-way stop at the intersection of Tyrol Terrace and Lillehammer Lane. Motion carried.

Public Services Director's Report: Gorman went through his monthly report and answered questions.

Future agenda items: Nothing at this time.

Adjourn: Motion by VanDomelen, seconded by White to adjourn the meeting at 6:46 pm. Motion carried.
