2022 Yard Waste/Brush Pickup Dates

Weeks of April 4th, 18th
Weeks of May 2nd, 16th, 30th
Weeks of June 13th, 27th
Weeks of July 11th, 25th
Weeks of August 8th, 22nd
Weeks of September 5th, 19th
Weeks of October 3rd, 17th, 31st
Weeks of November 14th, 28th

- Do not place yard waste/brush in the street. Yard waste/brush should be piled loose behind the curb away from objects such as trees, posts and fire hydrants.
- Have your brush and yard waste at the curb by 7:00am Monday morning, the week of pickup.
- The Village encourages residents to drop off their yard waste/brush at the Village compost site.
- THE VILLAGE DOES NOT PICK UP GRASS CLIPPINGS. RESIDENTS ARE URGED TO TAKE CLIPPINGS TO THE VILLAGE COMPOST SITE OR COMPOST AT HOME.

2022 Leaf Pickup Dates

****Every Week October through the end of November****

- Do not put leaves in the street or in bags.
- Leaves should be piled loose on the terrace away from objects such as trees, posts and fire hydrants.
- Please do not mix leaves with brush.

COMPOST SITE

The compost site is open April 1 through November 30, 8am-dusk every day.

This site is for VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY. NO CONTRACTORS.

The site is located south of the Village at 2466 Docken Road. Take Blue Mounds Street south under the Hwy 18-151 bridge. Docken Road is the first right turn after the Hwy. 151 bridge.

The compost site is for brush, yard waste, grass clippings, and leaves only. Please dump composting materials out of containers. No dumping is allowed outside the fenced area. Dumping ANYTHING other than compost materials is strictly forbidden and subject to a \$200 fine. Violators will be prosecuted.

PLEASE DO YOUR PART TO KEEP THE COMPOST SITE CLEAN!
