

The General Election is on Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. The polls are open from 7am-8pm. Both polling locations will be open for this election, which are the Mount Horeb Public Library and the Mount Horeb Senior Center. If you do not know where you need to go to vote, please visit [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) to find your location.

Protocols will be in place at both locations to keep poll workers and voters safe. We will be using plexiglass barriers, sanitizing all surfaces regularly, marking six-foot distances between voters, and utilizing masks and gloves according to state and CDC guidelines.

If you have recently moved to the village, or within the village, and need to register, you can do so by mail, online, or in-person. The deadline to register by mail, or online at [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) is 11:59pm on Wednesday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. After that date, you will need to register in-person at the Village Office. The registration deadline to register-in person is 5:00pm on Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>. You may register at the polls on election day as well.

We will start conducting in-person absentee voting on Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup> on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Municipal Building, in the Conference Room. The hours will be 7:30am-4:00pm Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup> thru Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 7:30am-11:30am Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 7:30am-4:00pm Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup> thru Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, and 7:30am-5:00pm Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>. If you would like to request an absentee ballot be sent to you by mail, please do so as early as you can, in order to leave enough time to get your ballot back to us by 8pm on Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. If you have access to the internet, please go to [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) to request your absentee ballot.

The Wisconsin Elections Commission sent out a mailer on September 1<sup>st</sup> to all voters who had not requested their November ballot by June 30<sup>th</sup>. This mailer includes a form to request your absentee ballot. If you are not able to request your ballot online, please follow the instructions in the mailer on how to fill out that form and mail it back to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. If you are unsure if you have an absentee request on file for the November election, you may go to [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) to see your request, or contact the Village Clerk's office if you are still unsure.

Absentee ballots will be mailed out on Thursday, September 17<sup>th</sup> to all requests on file at that time. The deadline to request your absentee ballot is Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm. Once you have voted your absentee ballot, you may mail it back to the Village Office using the Certification Envelope provided, place

it in our night deposit box right outside the front door of our office, or walk it in to our office if you feel comfortable doing so. We currently do not have another drop box in the Village. Please be sure that you as the voter sign the envelope your ballot goes in to, and that your witness's signature and address is provided as well. Your ballot will not be counted if these three things are not provided.

Please contact me if you have any questions on the voting or election process. I am also still looking for poll workers, so if you are interested, please contact me. Poll workers are compensated, unless they choose to volunteer their time.
