VILLAGE OF MOUNT HOREB VILLAGE BOARD MEETING MINUTES JUNE 2, 2021

The Village Board met in regular session in the Board Room of the Municipal Building, 138 E. Main Street, Mount Horeb, WI.

<u>Consider TIF Agreement, Tax Agreement, and Municipal Revenue Obligation</u> <u>for Wyser Properties, LLC:</u> Owen explained this item. Fendrick <u>moved</u>, Scott seconded to approve all three agreements. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

<u>Committee reports:</u> Committee reports were heard with none requiring Village Board action.

<u>Village President's report:</u> Littel welcomed Youth-In-Government Student Delaney Mertz back to in-person meetings. He stated the Frolic is being held next weekend, and also thanked the staff for things going well in the village.

<u>Village Administrator's report:</u> Owen did not have anything to report.

Motion carried by roll call vote. No action was taken in closed session.
